



Our centre in Kent is set in 58 acres of beautiful enclosed woodland and is close to both London and the south coast. Carroty Wood has up to 168 beds and is our busiest centre with most weekdays and weekends full from March through to November.

LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

Carroty Wood has 21 instructed activities on offer including; abseiling, high ropes, archery, bushcraft and offsite canoeing and kayaking. There is an indoor swimming pool so you will get a lot of lifeguard experience and the centre has use of a lake for offsite paddle sports. Carroty Wood welcomes a lot of youth groups and organisations such as the Princes Trust and you will have plenty of opportunities to develop your youth worker skills. School guests are offered morning assemblies with a Christian message which are led by instructors. Throughout the year there are a variety of offsite training trips organised to places such as the Peak District and North Wales.

LOCAL LIFE

The centre is just outside of the busy town of Tonbridge in rural Kent. Tonbridge is home to nearly 40,000 and has a range of churches representing most denominations including Hillsong, New Frontiers, CofE, Catholic and Baptist churches. There are plenty of shops and a train station linked to London in around 30 minutes and Hastings on the south coast. Tonbridge Wells is around 10 minutes away by train or 15 minutes' drive and has a cinema and bowling alley. Instructors are encouraged to take part in local church community life.

GUESTS

Carroty Wood has a range of guests from primary schools, church groups, youth groups and organisations such as Princes Trust and NCS (National Citizen Service). You may also be leading corporate team building sessions, family activities and holiday clubs, with Christian discussion and teaching.

STAFF ACCOMMODATION

Instructors will stay in single bedrooms in one of two onsite flats. Wi-Fi is available throughout.

TEAM SIZE

There are around 25 people that work at Carroty Wood. Approximately two thirds of those are instructors.

DISCIPLESHIP

Trainee instructors at all centres will receive ongoing discipleship. Daily devotional message sessions are held every Monday to Saturday morning for all staff as well as monthly worship meetings.
