

SUPERVISION WHEN NOT ON ACTIVITIES

Visiting group staff/leaders act *in loco parentis* for the duration of the visit. Rock UK have qualified First Aiders on all instructed activities and operates an emergency 'on call' system 24 hours a day.

RISK ASSESSMENTS

All Risk Assessments are inspected as part of our Adventure Activities Licence requirements. Copies of activity risk assessments can be viewed on site if required.

INSURANCE

Gallagher act as Insurance Brokers on behalf of Rock UK Adventure Centres Ltd. Rock UK currently hold Employers, Public and Product Liability, and Trustees Indemnity covers. Details of cover can be provided to group leaders if required.
